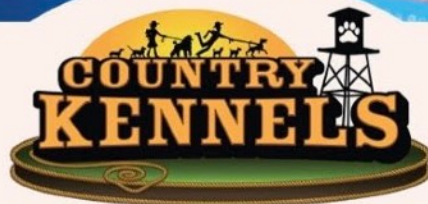

By restoring a healthy microbiome, probiotics can potentially reduce allergic reactions and improve skin health.

Just as in humans, gut health in dogs can influence mental well-being. Certain strains of probiotics are believed to have an impact on behavior and mood regulation. In dogs that experience anxiety or stress, particularly during situational changes like moving or vet visits, probiotics may help mitigate these feelings by promoting a healthy gut environment.

Improving a healthy gut is crucial for optimal nutrient absorption. Probiotics can aid in breaking down food and synthesizing essential nutrients, allowing dogs to derive maximum benefit from their diet. This is especially important for puppies and adult dogs with unique nutritional needs.

According to a recent study at Cornell University College of Veterinary Medicine, they found that over weight dogs were able to lose weight when given probiotics. Their diet was not changed and neither was their exercise routine. They also noticed a significant change in body condition scores, Inflammation levels and metabolism.

Blood work done, before and after the study, found that there was improvement in Cholesterol and other lipids, liver values and insulin.

Choosing the Right Probiotic for your dog is crucial. Choose a product specifically formulated for canines. Not all probiotic strains are suitable for dogs, and some may be ineffective or even harmful. Look for probiotics that contain strains supported by research for canine use.

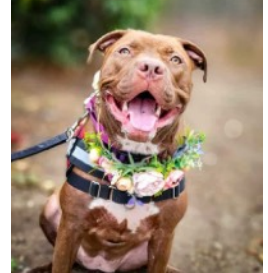
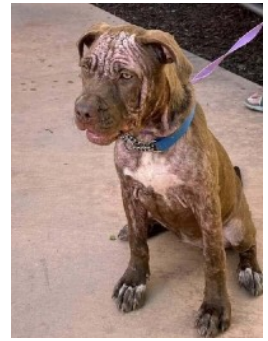
Bianca was rescued from a local shelter when she was just four months old. This adorable pit bull mix had a challenging case of mange, but it was non-contagious and easily treatable.
